The City of South Fulton's Parks and Recreation Department has taken a groundbreaking step towards engaging the youth and combating recidivism rates by introducing the first-ever Balling After Dark basketball league. Designed exclusively for young individuals aged 18 to 24, this unique initiative aims to utilize basketball as a catalyst to promote positive behavior and foster personal development. By strategically organizing games on Friday nights, when statistical data indicates a higher likelihood of unruly behavior within this age group, the City of South Fulton is proactively providing a healthy and constructive alternative for young individuals to spend their evenings.



SUPPORTING OUR YOUTH THROUGH READING

Councilman Reeves believes reading with children and getting parents involved in schools. Reading with children is crucial for their cognitive and emotional development. It helps improve their vocabulary, comprehension, and critical thinking skills. Additionally, reading with children can also be a great bonding experience between parents and their kids.

ENGAGING WITH OUR COMMUNITY



SPONSORED LEGISLATION

- An emergency ordinance enhancing operational efficiency, addressing City regulations in state of emergencies, amending Title I, Chapter 9 of the City's procurement policies and for other lawful purposes.
- An emergency ordinance amending Title 15, criminal offenses, of the City of South Fulton, Georgia, code of ordinances: providing regulations for the control of weapons discharge; enhancing public safety and for other lawful purposes.
- An ordinance amending Appendix G of the City of South Fulton, Georgia, Code of Ordinances; dissolving certain City entities due to budgetary and staffing hardships and for other lawful purposes. An ordinance amending Title 6, health and sanitation of the City of South Fulton Code of Ordinances; creating property maintenance regulations; enhancing public health and for other lawful purposes.
- An ordinance enhancing public safety, amending Title 15, criminal offenses, and Title 6, health and sanitation, of the City Code of Ordinances; updating smoke-free air regulations within the City and for other lawful purposes.
- An ordinance to be known as the South Fulton Crown Act, amending Title 15, criminal offenses, of the City Code of Ordinances to prohibit business, housing, and public accommodation discrimination based on protective and cultural hair textures and hairstyles within the City and for other lawful purposes. A resolution requesting sales tax information from the Georgia Department of Revenue pursuant to O.C.G.A. §48-2-15(d.1), naming a designated officer and for other lawful purposes.
- A resolution amending the membership the City of South Fulton Development Authority and for other lawful purposes. An emergency resolution encouraging landlords, mortgage companies, the governor, U.S. President and U.S. Congress to implement practices and programs to help protect the public from the housing hardships caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and for other lawful purposes.
- A resolution recognizing the looming housing crisis as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic; requesting assistance from State and federal agencies to help offset the burden on the public at the local level and for other lawful purposes.
- An ordinance prohibits smoking and vaping in city buildings, other enclosed public facilities and certain areas of outdoor public venues.
